## **BILA MUUJI ORAL HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP - 2010**

- ELIGIBILITY:** Students entering the second year of the Bachelor of Oral Health (BoH) program, having successfully completed the requirements of the first year of the BoH program.
- CAMPUS:** Wagga Wagga
- VALUE:** \$7000
- TENURE:** Two years
- CONDITIONS:** To be allocated in instalments according to successful completion of study: \$1500 in April 2010, \$1500 in September 2010, \$2000 in April 2011, \$2000 in September 2011.  
The scholarship will be presented at the scholarship ceremony providing a grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.  
The successful candidate will be required to undertake a Graduate Work Placement undertaking Oral Health Therapy work for a guaranteed minimum of 12 months with the Greater Western Area Health Service (GWAHS). The graduate will be based in Dubbo for the first six (6) months and will receive mentorship from GWAHS senior clinicians. The second six (6) months and any subsequent time will be spent providing oral health services to Bila Muuji sites.
